Dear PSR Families:

This letter is in regards to the 2020-2021 PSR year at Sacred Heart. PLEASE take the time to read through this entire letter.

## CLASS DAYS AND TIMES

- Classes begin the week of Sunday, 4 October 2020. All grade levels (grades 1-8, as well as 9<sup>th</sup> grade Confirmation preparation) will meet virtually throughout the fall. Classes may be pre-recorded or held “live” via a virtual classroom on Sundays from 9:15-10:15am.
- Alternatives to virtual classes (eg. home-schooling) should be discussed with your child’s catechist and approved by Shelly Bussard, the PSR coordinator; this is only a potential option for those in non-sacramental preparation years.

## PSR REGISTRATION FORMS

- The PSR registration form for the 2020-2021 academic year is included with this letter. For returning students the form is pre-printed; please provide (or update) any missing (or errant) information. Additional blank forms may be downloaded from <https://psr.shoj.cc>
- Even with virtual learning a PSR fee is still assessed to help cover the cost of student textbooks, which run \$19.95 each + shipping; bibles cost us \$12.68.  
Current tuition fees:
  - For Sacred Heart Parishioners are:
    - \$10/child if paid by 9/13/2020
    - \$20/child if paid after 9/13/2020
  - For those registered at another Catholic parish we ask at least:
    - \$25/child if paid by 9/13/2020, AND
    - \$35/child if paid after 9/13/2020
    - As the Sunday collection heavily subsidizes the PSR program, we ask a bit more of those who provide their financial support to another parish community.
  - As always, financial hardship on your part should never be a reason for not sending your child to PSR. If you have any difficulty paying the PSR fee for your child(ren), please contact Fr. Trask so that he may adjust or waive the fees – according to what is most appropriate to your situation.

As PSR costs are almost totally covered through the Sunday collection (PSR fees only cover about 15% of our actual costs) we ask: that registered parishioners of Sacred Heart pay \$10 per child (\$20/child if submitted after 9/13/2020) - and; that members of other Catholic parishes who send their child(ren) to Sacred Heart PSR pay at least \$25 per child (\$35/child if submitted after 9/13/2020). **ALL FEES** should be REMITTED WITH THIS FORM, but must be remitted no later than the first day of class. And, as always, anyone having difficulty paying a PSR fee is asked to speak with Fr. Trask so that fees may be reduced or waived.
